

Baldwyn Public Schools Promotes Child Find

The Baldwyn School District is involved in an ongoing statewide effort to identify, locate, and evaluate children up to the age of twenty-one who may have physical, mental, communicative and/or emotional disabilities. Early identification of children in need of special educational experiences is most important. The information gathered from contact with parents and other agencies will be used to help determine present and future program needs as progress is made toward the goal of providing a free appropriate public education to all children with disabilities.

The Child Find Coordinator implements child identification, location and evaluation of children who have a disability, regardless of the severity of the disability, and who may need special education services. This person should be contacted to seek help for any child who is suspected of having a disability. The Baldwyn School District provides special education services for students with disabilities and complies with The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
