LOCATION & USE OF FACILITIES

- BHS auditorium will be used for the presentation of contestants. BHS Band Hall will be used as the dressing room area for contestants and one adult for each participant.
- All participants and guests are asked to please make sure all garbage and personal belongings are collected from the school facilities at the end of the beauty revue.
- Any items left behind will be trashed or placed in the office's lost and found box.
- Please do NOT move or use any of the school properties such as instruments, music stands, etc.
- An additional BHS classroom may be used as a dressing room if necessary.

PRACTICE & PRESENTATION

- ALL participants are required to attend practice and arrive at the beauty revue at the assigned time. If a participant is late to the pageant, it will be the judges' discretion whether the participant will be viewed or not.
- Practice will include a demonstration of the beauty revue walk on stage along with the order of ceremonies which includes parade of beauties, individual walks, and group presentations.
- Missing practice can forfeit the participant's knowledge of the beauty revue walk and order of ceremonies. Adult sponsors can NOT guarantee time to personally demonstrate instructions to participants. However, each situation will be considered with care.
- It is highly suggested that the participant bring beauty revue shoes to practice on stage.
- During the presentation of beauties, no one is allowed backstage or in the dressing room until after winners have been announced. If

an emergency arises, parents will be notified promptly. When returning to the dressing room, parties should enter the band hall by exiting the auditorium through the foyer. NO ONE will be allowed to enter the backstage area or band hall from the side entrance where contestants are entering the stage.

PHOTOS

- No professional photographers will be scheduled for the event. The stage will be open from 5:00 p.m. and before for private photos if desired.
- Any participant is welcome to have personal photos made off campus prior to the event.
- A group photo of winners will be taken by the BHS yearbook staff and/or *The Baldwyn News* or other professional media on site.

JUDGING

- Three judges will be hired with at least one head judge having pageant certification.
- Judges will decide upon the order of viewing of top 10 and/or finalists.
- **Scoring sheets will NOT be available to participants or the public.**
- Judges will only know first names and numbers of contestants.
- *If a division has 5 or less total number of participants, then judges will determine the number of alternates with one Most Beautiful. No Top 10 will be called. *If a division has 6-9 total number of participants, then only three participants will place with two alternates and one Most Beautiful. No Top 10 will be called. *If a division has 10 or more total number of participants, then 5 participants will place as with four alternates and one Most Beautiful. Division must have 15 or more participants for a Top 10 to be called. Top 10 will be at the judges' discretion.
- Communication with the judges prior or during the event can become grounds for

being dismissed from school property and/or disqualification of a contestant.

MISSION

The goal of this event is to create an opportunity for female students to showcase their beauty and confidence in an environment that is supportive.

The event also serves as a fundraiser for the BHS Journalism class and yearbook.
