Baldwyn School District will reduce the retention rates in grades Kindergarten, first and second in the following ways:

- Ensure that early literacy instruction is aligned to Mississippi's academic standards
- Ensure programs and practices are based on best practices
- Early interventions for struggling readers
- 4 year-old Head Start classroom housed at Baldwyn Elementary School
- Provide resources and training for Head Start and other local childcare learning centers
- Supplemental resources will be used to create, compare, and analyze test data
- Remediation provided by retired teachers in subject area content
- School Status Reports
- Provide ongoing professional development tied to the needs of the students

Baldwyn School District will target subgroups that need additional assistance to meet graduation requirements in the following ways:

- Implement programs and practices that meet the individual education needs of students
- Compare and analyze test data through online resources
- In-school Tutorial teacher will monitor attendance, grades, behavior, etc. through School Status and serve as a liaison between home and school
- Remediation provided by retired teachers in subject area content
- MAAP data will be used to identify deficit areas

Baldwyn School District will develop dropout recovery initiatives for students age 17-21 who dropped out of school in the following ways:

- Reach out and refer students to the Mississippi Works job resources
- Work with local community college to host a Career & Technical Fair
- Referrals to Gateway Youth Program at Northeast Mississippi Community College
- Make referrals to different agencies and organizations as needed

Baldwyn School District will address how students will transition to the home school district from the juvenile detention centers in the following ways:

- Develop school-based programs and initiatives that promote positive behavior and student success
- In-school tutorial teacher will monitor attendance, grades, behavior, etc. and serve as a liaison between home and school
- In-school tutoring will be provided by retired teachers
- School counselors and/or mental health therapists will work with them to develop a plan to promote academic success, decrease inappropriate behavior, set realistic goals, etc.
